

Speech Sound Development Chart



As children develop, they often modify speech sounds by omitting, adding, or changing sounds into an easier form. Some sounds are easier to say and should be mastered by an earlier age. The majority of children can form most of the speech sounds by age 4. If you are concerned about your child's speech, schedule a conversation with their physician.
